

Product Description

Avatec® (*lasalocid*) is a Type A Medicated Article for the prevention of coccidiosis in poultry. Avatec contains 90.7 grams (20%) of lasalocid sodium activity per pound of premix.

Indications for Use

- For the prevention of coccidiosis in broiler chickens, growing turkeys and chukar partridges.
- Prevents coccidiosis caused by Eimeria tenella,
 E. necatrix, E. acervulina, E. brunetti, E. mivati,
 E. maxima, E. meleagrimitis, E. gallopavonis,
 E. adenoeides and E. legionensis.

Key Points

- Avatec provides rotation program advantages for both broiler chickens and turkeys as the only available divalent ionophore.
- Highly effective, broad spectrum and kills at the first stage of development.
- Provides year-round (non-seasonal) coccidiosis protection.
- No depression of feed or water intake.

FDA Status

- Category 1 drug and does not require a feedmill license for manufacture of medicated feeds.
- Approved for use in combination with, but not limited to, BMD[®] (broilers, fryers and turkeys) and Lincomix[®] (broilers).*
- If Avatec is used in combination with Lincomix, a VFD is required.

Storage and Packaging

- Store below 25°C (77°F); excursions permitted to 37°C (99°F).
- Avatec is packaged in a 50-pound, multiwall paper bag with protective barrier ply.

Withdrawal Information

No withdrawal is required prior to slaughter.

Poultry Information: Lasalocid Sodium — Type A Medicated Article

Active Drug Ingredient	Each pound contains 90.7 g (20%) of lasalocid sodium activity in a carrier suitable for incorporation in feed.		
Mixing Directions	Thoroughly mix the following amounts of Avatec to make one ton of feed to provide from 68 g per ton (0.0075%) to 113 g per ton (0.0125%) lasalocid sodium concentration. When adding less than one pound of premix per ton of feed, it is recommended that the premix first be mixed with a small amount of feed (10 to 25 lb.) prior to incorporation into the final feed.

Limitations	Feed continuously as the sole ration.		
Warning	When mixing and handling lasalocid premix, use protective clothing, impervious gloves and a dust mask. Avoid contact with eyes. Operators should wash thoroughly with soap and water after handling.		

Note: In addition to label statements of identity, ingredients and directions for use, labeling of feeds containing Avatec must contain the following statements:

For Broiler or Fryer Chickens Only and/or For Growing Turkeys Only For Chukar Partridges (up to 8 weeks of age) Only Restricted Drug (California) - Use only as directed. Not for human use.

Feed continuously as the sole ration.
